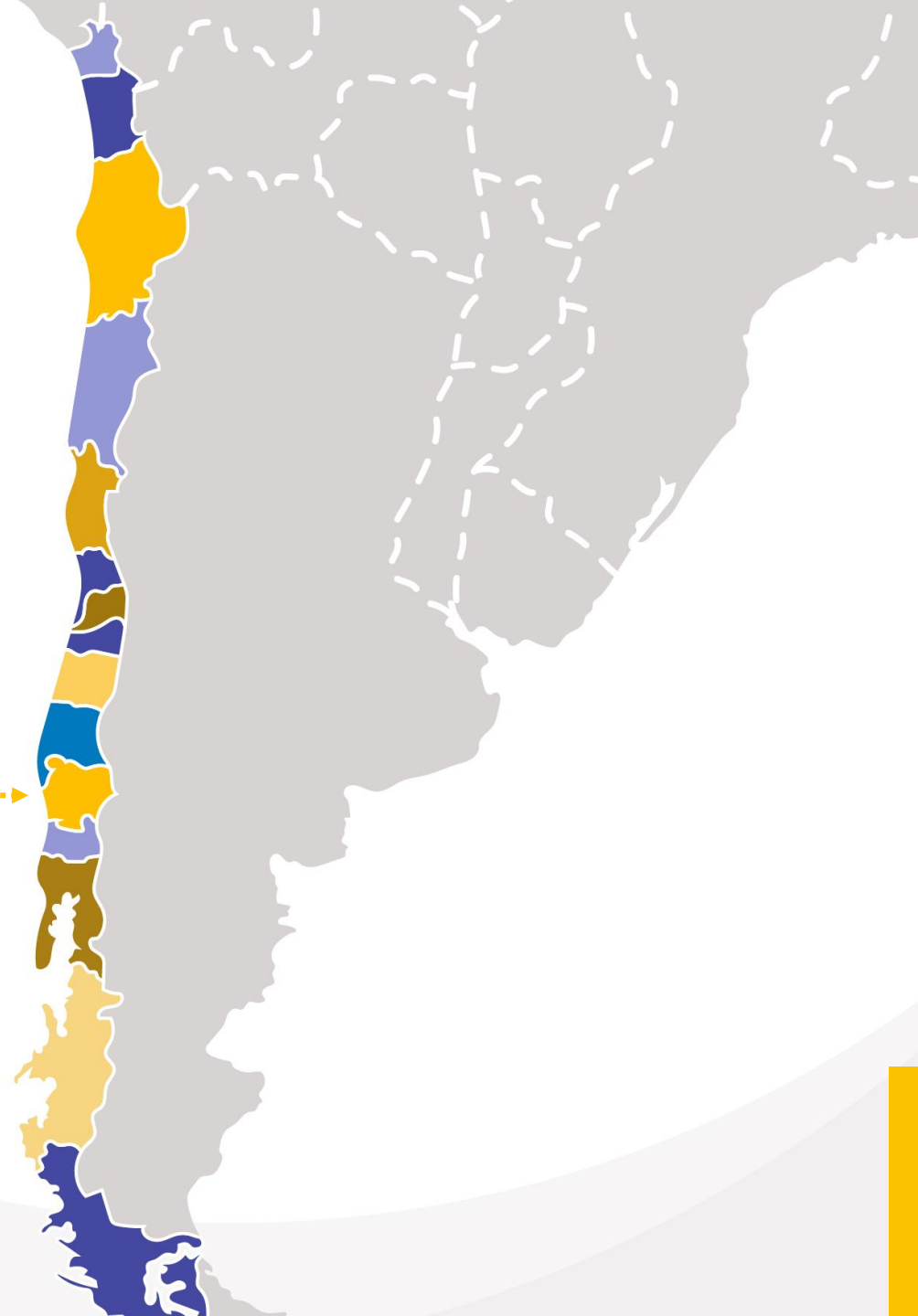


Where are we?
